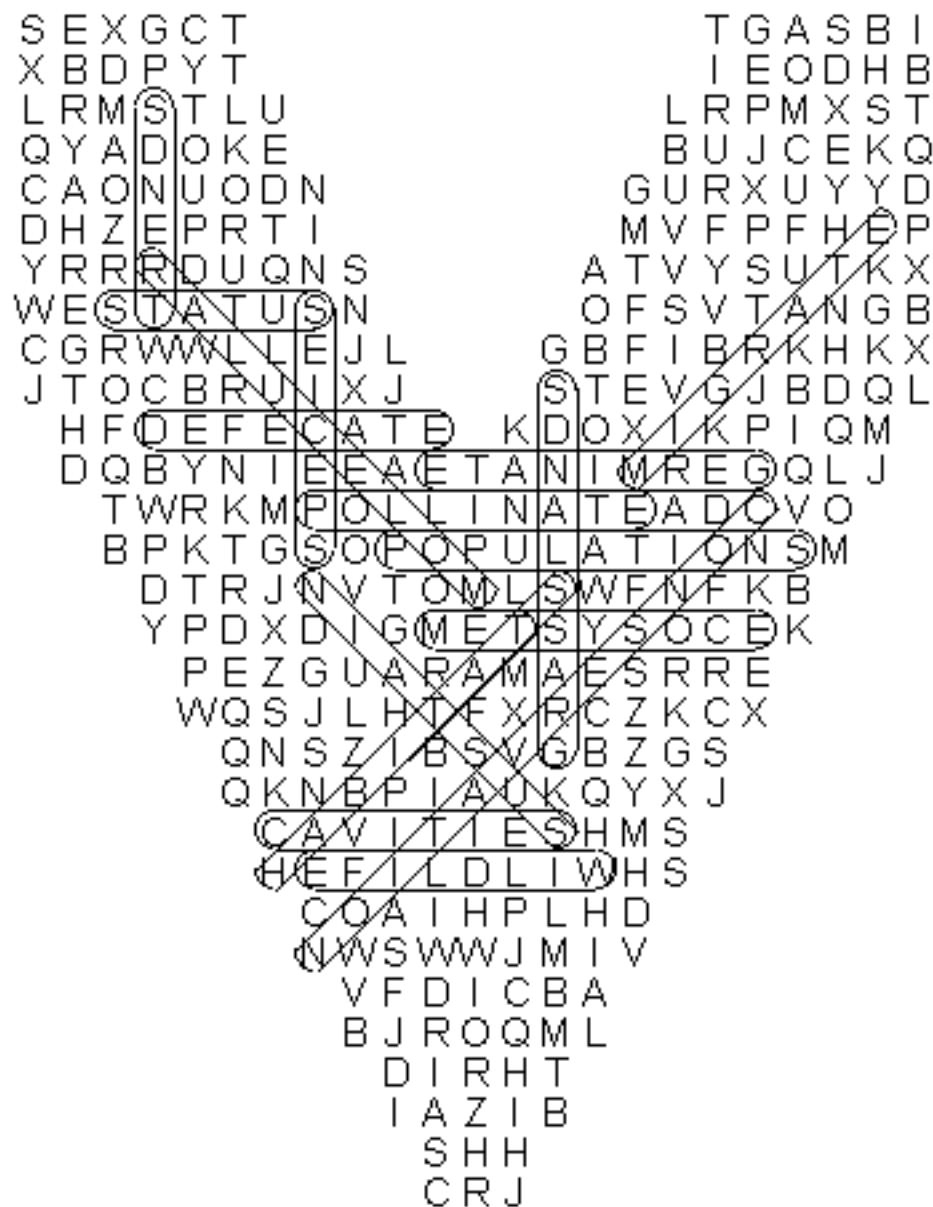


## Born To Be Wild

12. (populations) The total number of individuals of separate types of plants or animals occupying an area.
13. (pecker) Groups of organisms that resemble one another in appearance, behavior, chemical processes, and genetic structure.
14. (status) The state or condition of something.
15. (sustain) To keep up or maintain.
16. (tracks) The directions or courses that things take.
17. (wildlife) Animals that live in the wild.
