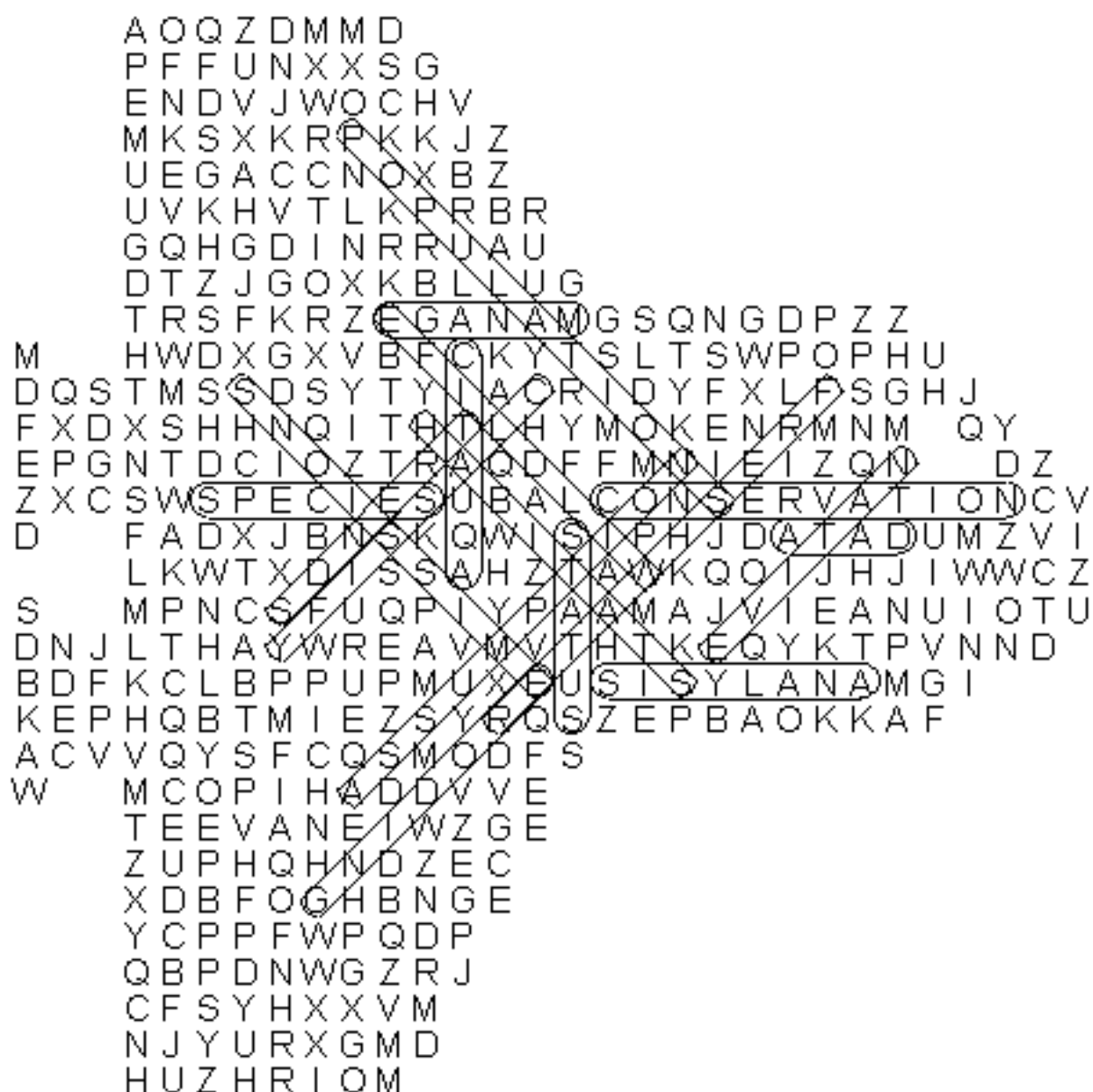


One Fish Two Fish Red Fish No Fish
