Name of Article	Research Question	Findings	Implications
Ex. <i>What you see is not what you get</i>	Does the shade under urban trees protect humans from UVB radiation?	-tree crowns do not allow much light to pass through -visible radiation has higher reflectivity than invisible UVB -if you can see the sky where you are standing you are receiving some amount of UVB radiation -urban trees in sunny areas help block some UVB radiation	-In a dense canopy of trees, you are better protected from UVB than if you are standing under just one tree. -Larger, older trees provide greater protection from UVB
