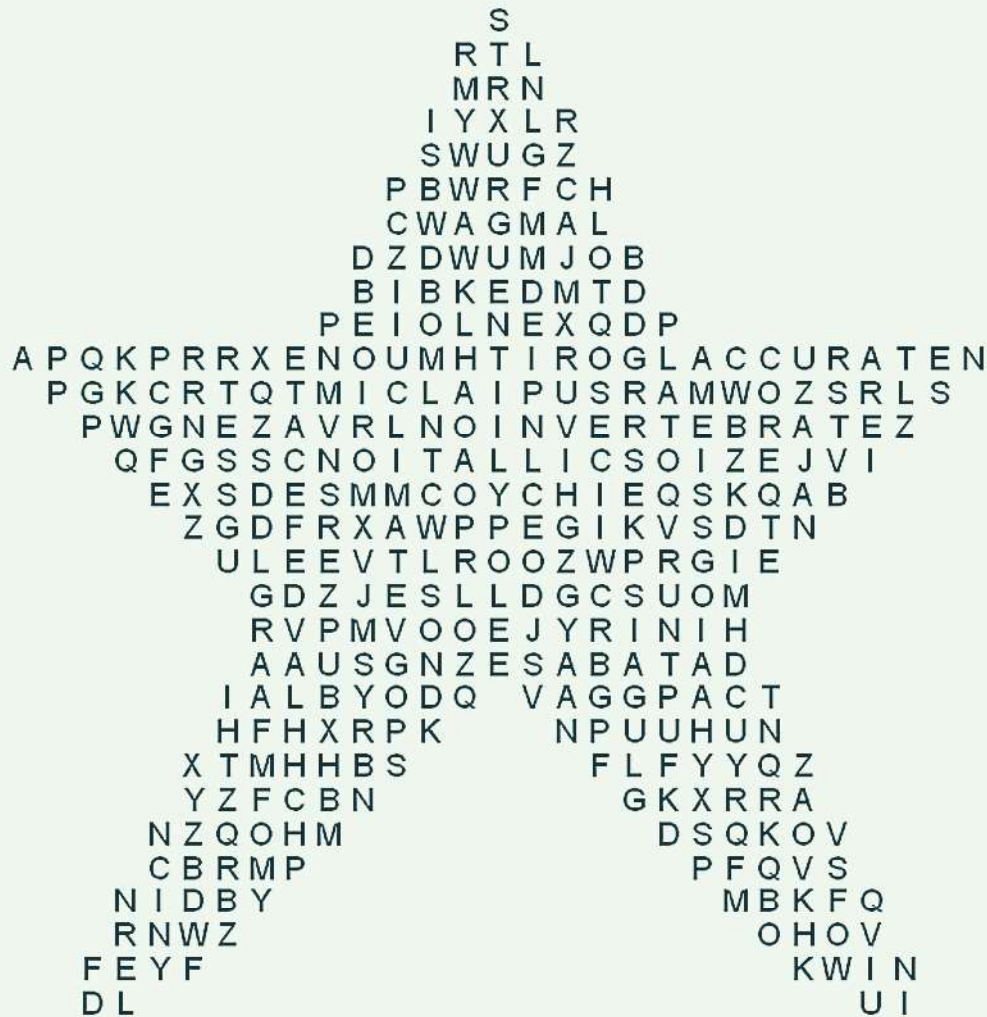


Climate Change Word Search
