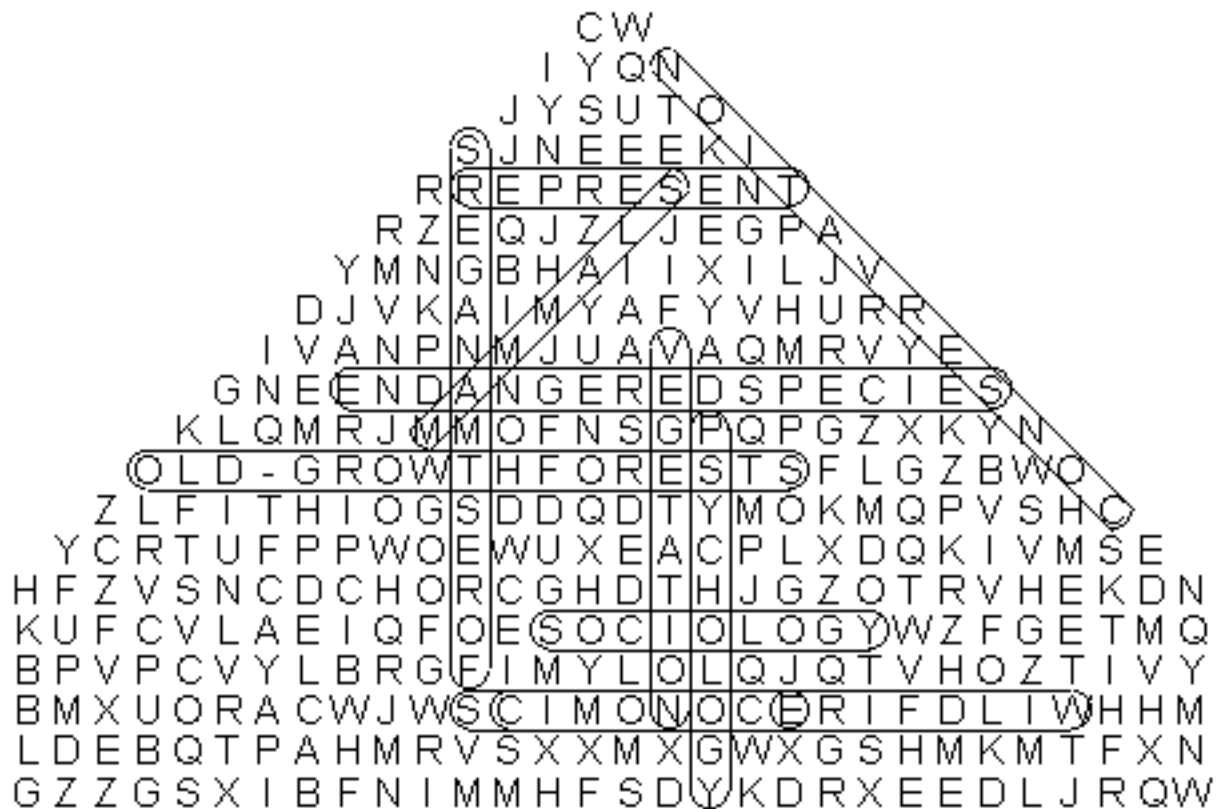


Who Gives a Hoot



- (conservation) The care and protection of natural resources such as forests and water.
