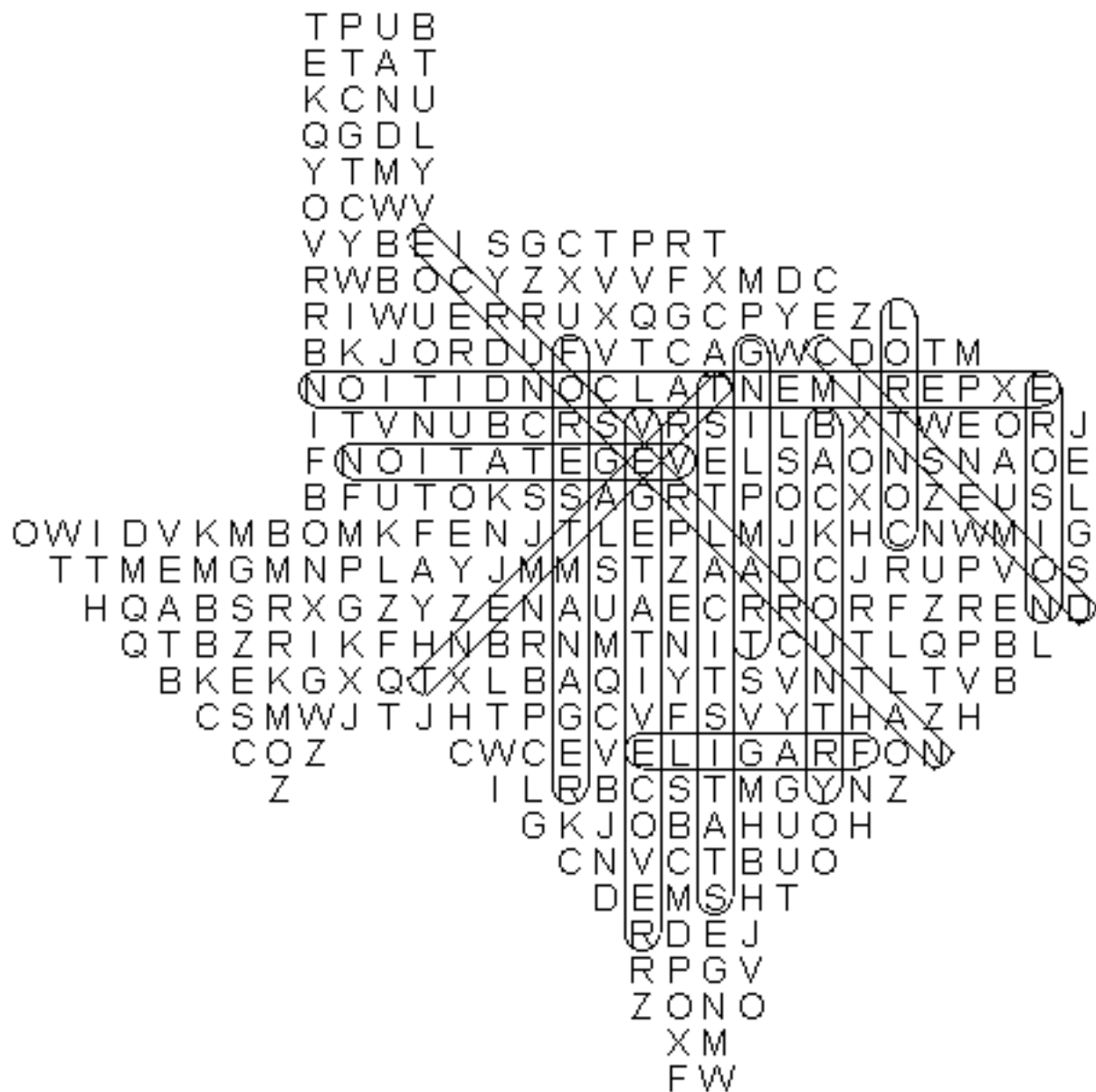


Quit Yer Horsin' Around



- (back country) A large natural area with little or no human development.
- (control) Situation in which the experimental treatment is withheld, used as a comparison.
- (domestic) Raised to live in a tame condition.
- (erosion) The state of being destroyed by wearing away.
- (experimental condition) A situation purposely created to run a test or trial.
- (forest manager) A person who takes specific actions to protect and to use natural resources in a forest.
- (fragile) Easily damaged.
- (natural resource) Goods occurring in nature that are used by humans.
- (statistical test) A test that uses numbers and probability to determine relationship.
- (trampling) Treading or stepping heavily.
- (treatment) A purposeful action taken to test something or run a trial.
- (vegetation) All the plants or plant life in a place.
- (vegetative cover) Layer of green vegetation.
