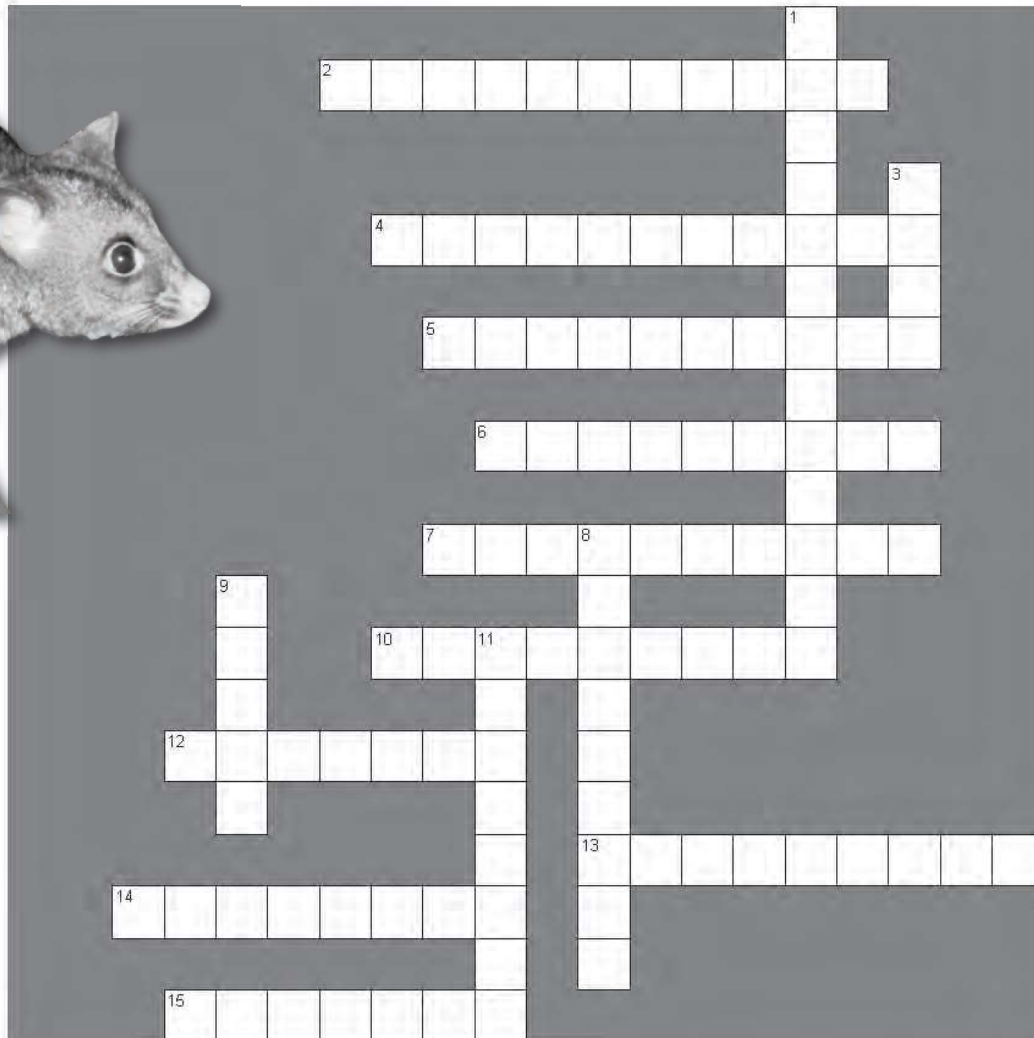


Southern United States Climate Change Crossword Puzzle
