The mission of the Forest Service is to sustain the health, diversity, and productivity of the Nation's forests and grasslands to meet the needs of present and future generations. There are 154 national forests and 20 grasslands in 44 States, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. National forests and grasslands make up 8.5 percent of the total land area in the Nation. Our Research and Development, State, Private, and Tribal Forestry, and International Programs extend technical expertise and outreach to forest landowners around the world.
