

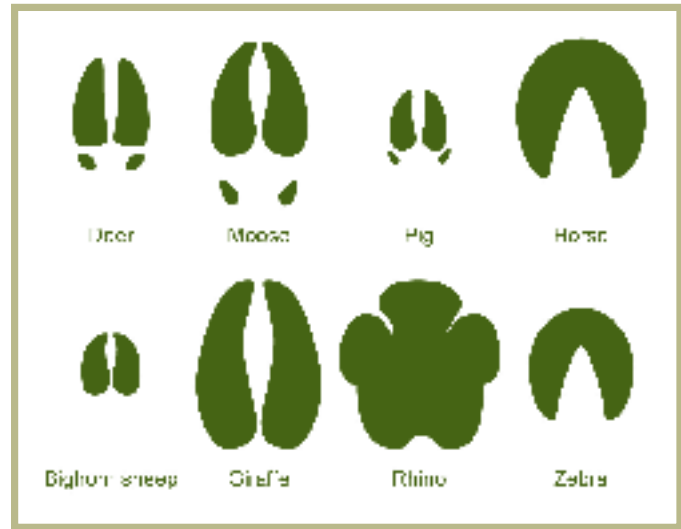
Making Sense of Ungulate Tracks
